Since the Lilac Festival is an outdoor event, there will be NO REFUNDS in the event of inclement weather. Also, there will be no refunds given under any circumstances and booth sharing is NOT allowed.

Though all of our vendor applications are screened for quality and craftsmanship, we operate on a first-come, first-served basis, so please submit your signed application along with payment at your earliest opportunity. We give additional priority to those vendors who have been with us before and attempt to whenever possible accommodate location requests, although there is no guarantee implied of granting a certain booth space.

As a true festival of quality and unique crafts, we are always interested in locating other distinctive vendors (besides yourself) so if you know of any; please pass our contact information along to them.

No silly string, water pistols, exploding caps and the like are permitted. This is just a partial list of prohibited items, but we hope that you will understand that any such item that creates a mess or causes a nuisance or disturbance takes away from the beauty and ambiance of the event.

Vendors may set up after 5pm on the Friday before the festival but are responsible for any valuables or inventory left at the vendor space. While every attempt is made to keep the area secure, and we have had no known problems in the past, the Lilac Festival and the Pine Mountain Club Commercial Property Owners Association and its agents are to be held harmless for any liability or loss caused by theft, destruction, or any other means.
